Details for Applicants

St Piran's is a family school for boys and girls from rising 3 to 11 years. The ratio is about 60% boys to 40% girls, taking the school as a whole, but closer to 50:50 in KS1. St Piran's is a non-selective, mixed ability school offering a broad and balanced curriculum in line with the National Curriculum. We prepare all children for entry to their senior school at 11+ whether Grammar School or Independent.

The school has evolved over the years from a single-sex boys' boarding school to its current standing. Co-education started in 1993 with the opening of the Nursery. Full boarding stopped in 2000. There are currently 390 pupils on roll with a staff of over 80 and many ancillary staff. The school stands in about 11 acres of land and has ample facilities for sport and recreation.

We are a three form entry school from Reception to Year 6 with a maximum of 18 pupils per class. Pupils enter KS1 almost exclusively from our own Nursery, which is on site.

Nursery to Year 2 are class taught and linked as Pre-Prep. This is overseen by the Head of Pre Prep. Years 3 and 4, our Middle School, are also class taught, overseen by the Head of Middle School. There are an increasing number of specialist lessons as children move up the school. From Year 5 all teaching is by subject specialists.

The Senior Management Team consists of the Headmaster, Deputy Head, Director of Studies, Head of Pre-Prep and the Bursar.

The school is positively Christian with daily assemblies and bible-based RE Lessons. There is a weekly Chapel service for children in Years 5 and 6 to which parents are invited. We pride ourselves on being a family school as well, encouraging parental involvement at many levels. There is a thriving parent and staff committee that organises social and fundraising events.

We have a strong tradition of sport and music with the St Piran's Centre for Sport and the Performing Arts providing outstanding facilities. This includes music teaching and practice rooms, sports hall, indoor swimming pool and dance studio.

Our last inspection in 2015 was extremely successful and identified aspects of excellent delivery in all areas of the school. The full copy can be read on our website.
