Chess

The AJA Chess Academy will again be offering chess tuition to St Piran's pupils at school on a Monday afternoon during the Christmas Term. This renowned academy offers professional tuition and coaching and a chess syllabus, working towards the Bronze, Silver and Gold awards.

Mr Aslett is a professional schools chess coach and works at seven other schools teaching and coaching chess. His syllabus covers Bronze, Silver and Gold. He also runs a chess Club of which two of the juniors currently play for the National England team.

Year 2

Junior Chess Club will continue to be offered for Year 2 children next term starting on **Monday 11th September** until **Monday 11th December** and will run for **13 weeks**. The cost will be **£97.50** per child. Children taking part in Chess will be taken to the English Classroom after school.

After the Chess Club the children should be picked up from the English Classroom at 4pm promptly.

Years 3

The 45 minute session will run from **4.25pm – 5.10pm** for children in Years 3 and 4. Lessons will commence on **Monday 11th September** and will run for **13 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Monday 11th December**. The cost is **£97.50**. There will be no session on **Monday 23rd October** due to Half Term.

Year 4

The 45 minute session will run from **4.25pm – 5.10pm** for children in Years 3 and 4. Lessons will commence on **Monday 11th September** and will run for **12 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Monday 11th December**. The cost is **£90**. There will be no session on **Monday 25th September** and **23rd October** due Half Term and Mill on the Brue.

Year 5

The 50 minute session will run from **5.10pm – 6pm** for children in Years 5 and 6. Lessons will commence on **Monday 11th September** and will run for **12 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Monday 11th December**. The cost is **£90**. There will be no session on **Monday 18th September** and **23rd October** due to Half Term and Osmington Bay.

Year 6

The 50 minute session will run from **5.10pm – 6pm** for children in Years 5 and 6. Lessons will commence on **Monday 11th September** and will run for **13 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Monday 11th December**. The cost is **£97.50**. There will be no session on **Monday 23rd October** due to Half Term.

Golf Tuition

Gavin Clark of Winter Hill Golf Club will once again be offering tuition to St Piran's pupils at School on a Tuesday afternoon during the Christmas Term.

In order for the children to gain the most benefit from these lessons, places have been strictly limited this year to a **maximum of 12 children**. Golf clubs will be provided, but children may bring in their own set. These should be stored in the changing rooms.

Years 3 & 4

Sessions will run from **4.25 – 5.10 p.m.** for children in **Years 3 and 4**. At the end of Middle School lessons, children should remain in School uniform but will need to take their indoor trainers over to the Sports Hall for the start of their golf tuition. During lessons, children will work towards the Golf Foundation's Award Scheme. All areas of golf tuition will be covered; woods, irons, pitching, chipping and putting. For safety reasons children must be collected at 5.10pm from the **Sports Hall**.

Lessons will commence on **Tuesday 12th September** and will run for **12 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Tuesday 5th December**. Please note that there will be no session on **Tuesday 24th October** due to Half Term. The cost will be **£144**.

Years 5 & 6

Sessions will run from **5.15 – 6.00 p.m.** for children in **Years 5 and 6**. Children should remain in school uniform but will need to take their outdoor trainers over to the top field for the start of their golf tuition. During lessons, children will work towards the Golf Foundation's Award Scheme. All areas of golf tuition will be covered; woods, irons, pitching, chipping and putting. For safety reasons children must be collected at 6.00pm from the **Sports Hall**.

Year 5

Lessons will commence on **Tuesday 11th September** and will run for **11 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Tuesday 5th December**. Please note that there will be no session on **Tuesday 19th September** and **24th October** due to Half Term and Osmington Bay. The cost will be **£132**.

Year 6

Gymnastics

Burnham gymnastics coach Will O'Neil will be offering a new gymnastics coaching programme on a Tuesday and Friday afternoon during the Christmas Term.

Will is a self-taught gymnast who has recently been competing where he won a national title for UK Gymnastics. He was previously the girls and boys head coach at Burnham and is a level 2 coach. He has completed his child protection training.

Years 1 & 2

In order for the children to gain the most benefit from these classes, places have been limited to a **maximum of 18 children per class**.

Tuesday (all abilities) - Lessons will commence on **Tuesday 12th September** and will run for **12 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Tuesday 5th December**. Please note there is no session on **Tuesday 24th October** due to half-term. The cost of these **12** lessons will be **£102**.

Friday (all abilities) - Lessons will commence on **Friday 8th September** and will run for **12 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Friday 8th December**. Please note there is no session on **Friday 20th and 27th October** due to half-term and Inset day. The cost for the lessons is **£102**.

Years 3 & 4

Sessions will run from **4.25 – 5.10pm** in the Tippet Hall; children will be collected by the coaches from outside the boys' changing rooms and taken over to the Tippet Hall. At the end of the session children will be brought back to the changing rooms at 5pm and can be collected from the front of school at 5.10pm. In order for the children to gain the most benefit from these classes, places have been limited to a **maximum of 18 children**.

Lessons will commence on **Tuesday 12th September** and will run for **12 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Tuesday 5th December**. Please note there is no session on **Tuesday 24th October** due to half-term. The cost of these **12** lessons will be **£102**.

Judo Years 3 - 6

Miss Victoria Hayden (2nd dan judo) will be offering judo lessons on Monday afternoons. Years 3 to 6 will have their session after school from 4.25pm until 5.10pm.

Years 3

Kickboxing

The kickboxing class will be run by The Samurai Fitness Group, Chief Instructor Matthew Collins. Matthew has over 18 years of martial art experience and a black belt in Judo, Tae Kwon-do and Kickboxing. On returning to England from Japan after teaching for 2 years in primary and middle schools Matthew set up The Samurai Fitness Group in 2010 and has now taught over 1,000 children how to kickbox!

The Samurai Fitness Group began with the sole intent of teaching kickboxing to children and they specialise in developing fitness, confidence, respect, discipline, self-protection and anti-bullying skills in their pupils.

Classes are great fun and by the end of the Christmas Term your child will have gained a comprehensive understanding of the sport and be able to take the test for their first belt should they wish! These tests are optional. In order for the children to gain the most benefit from these classes, places have been limited to a **maximum of 16 children**.

Years 3

Sessions will run from **4.25 – 5.10pm** in the Sports Hall. Children will be collected by the coaches from outside the boys' changing rooms and taken over to the Sports Hall. Please provide your child with a drink and a snack. At the end of the session, children can be collected from the Sports Hall at 5.10pm.

Years 5 & 6

Sessions will run after Chapel from **5.20–6pm** in the Sports Hall for children in **Years 5 and 6**. Children should change after Chapel and then make their way over to the Sports Hall. Please provide your child with a drink and a snack. At the end of the session, children can be collected from the Sports Hall at 6pm. **Please note if your child is part of bell ringing they may start the session slightly late due to ringing of the bells after Chapel and then go and get changed.**

Year 5

Quicksticks Hockey Years 1 and 2

Maidenhead Hockey Club's Director of Hockey, Paul Loudon will be offering a Quicksticks hockey coaching programme on a Thursday afternoon during the Christmas Term.

Quicksticks is a 4 a side game, which introduces young people to the game of hockey. It is fun, safe, exciting and allows more fun and game play without being too demanding on skill and technique. It can be played on a variety of surfaces and uses a larger, lighter and safer ball. All the skills taught are below head height such as pushing, low slap hitting, running with the ball, passing and control.

Paul is a level 2 and England Hockey registered coach with experience at national league coaching and employed as an outside specialist coach for many schools.

Sessions will run on Thursdays from **3.45 – 4.45pm** for children in Years 1 and 2. At the end of Lower School lessons, children will be collected by the coaches from the Millstone Garden area and taken over to the St. Piran's Centre, where they will change into their PE kit and indoor trainers ready for the start of the session in the Tippet Hall. Hockey sticks will be provided but children should wear shin guards. Please provide your child with a drink and a snack. At the end of the session children will be brought back to the Millstone Garden area at 5pm for those attending extended day, otherwise please pick your children up promptly from the Tippet Hall. In order for the children to gain the most benefit from these classes, places have been **limited to a maximum of 16 children**.

Lessons will commence on **Thursday 7th September** and will run for **10 weeks**. The last lesson will be on **Thursday 30th December**. Please note that there will be no session on **Thursday 19th, 26th October** and **2nd November** due to half term, parents evening and Bonfire night. The cost will be **£120**.

Sewing

Dhaaga runs an after school sewing club at St. Piran's on Tuesdays. Sewing is one of the important life skills which we teach with lots of fun. During this activity, children will develop hand-eye coordination, improve concentration and ability to focus and experience a sense of achievement. Children also learn how to use a sewing machine with confidence.

We undertake each project to make children learn something new and take it home when they finish it. All materials for projects are provided.

There are two groups;

Group 1: Year 1 & 2 – Time 3.30 to 4.15pm

Group 2: Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 – Time 4.20 to 5.20 pm.

Sessions will take place in the Big School Dining Room every Tuesday unless there is a swimming gala where it will take place in the LRC.

No of places: Minimum 8 to maximum 20 for each group.

Year 6

12 weeks (Starting 12th Sept to 5th Dec) no session Tuesday 24th October due to half term. The cost of these lessons is **£78** (All materials included).

Teach it Right

Teachitright is an 11+ tuition company which has provided support to students for 10 years. Our small groups (maximum of 10) and engaging sessions help children become familiar with the 11+ question types. The sessions at St Piran's are held on a **Tuesday afternoon (4:30pm – 6:30pm)** and **Saturday mornings (9:00am – 11:15am)** in Northside. Our experienced, qualified teachers who deliver the course have a vast knowledge of the CEM exam system and have supported students at St Piran's for the last 4 years.

These sessions support Year 5 children from September until July (36 sessions) and cover all four subjects: **Verbal reasoning (VR), Non-verbal reasoning (NVR), English (ENG) and Mathematics (MA)**.

The cost for a six-week block is £265 (this covers all materials provided). Teachitright also provide **FREE parent workshops** throughout the academic year and hold regular one-to-one meetings to ensure parents are kept well informed. Pupils are assessed every 5 weeks to ensure we know the areas of development.). At the end of the sessions children can be collected from Northside.

Year 4 courses are also offered on a **Saturday morning between 11:30am – 12:30pm**. These hourly sessions help build vocabulary and enhance numerical reasoning skills. The cost is £132.50 per six-week block.

Lessons will commence on **Tuesday 12th September**. The last lesson will be on **Tuesday 12th December**. Please note that there will be no session on **Tuesday 24th October** due to half term.

ThinkTank

ThinkTank's innovative programme for primary school children uses carefully selected games and puzzles from around the world to develop and sharpen children's **thinking, problem solving and interpersonal skills**. Year 6

Lessons will commence on **Wednesday 13th September** and will run for **12** weeks. The last lesson will be on **Wednesday 6th December**. Please note that there will be no sessions on **Wednesday 25th October** due to half term.
