

HANDING IN UNIFORM TO THE SHOP

Uniform should only be handed into the shop during opening times on a Tuesday/ Thursday.

Please be critical when reviewing uniform you are considering handing in for sale.

Uniform should be in a bag clearly marked with:

- Seller's name
- Phone number
- Whether the uniform is to be sold and proceeds donated to school funds OR if the seller would like a percentage of the proceeds back
- All uniform MUST be laundered
- Blazers MUST be dry cleaned before asking the shop to sell them on your behalf

There is no need to remove name tapes although uniform which has been labelled in permanent marker or iron on name tapes does not sell as well.

ITEMS NOT SOLD /ACCEPTED

There are a few items we cannot sell including:

- Underwear
- Socks / tights
- Swimming costumes.

Although we do not sell swimming costumes we can pass them on to Mrs Burnage to be kept as spares in the pool office.

NOTE

If it is worn, torn, faded or badly mended it may not be suitable for resale. We do not usually have the time during opening hours to review uniform handed in for sale.

We therefore reserve the right to discard uniform which is not suitable. In these instances these items will be passed to charity.

In our experience, uniform in good condition which has been laundered sells quickly and holds a higher resale value than uniform which has not.

Those which have not been dry cleaned usually sell for less as there is no guarantee to the buyer that any marks will come out.

This often results in having to lower the price to cover the buyer's dry cleaning or repair costs. We keep spare blazer buttons and badges should you require them.

LOCATION

SECOND HAND UNIFORM ITEMS STOCKED

The uniform shop stocks most items of second-hand uniform and sports kit for boys and girls in all sections of the school.

- Girls' Uniform - cardigans, pinafores, blouses, summer dresses
- Boys' Uniform - long/short grey sleeve shirts, white shirts, shorts, trousers, jumpers
- Sports Kit - netball skirts, rugby shorts, PE navy shorts, tracksuits, rugby/hockey long sleeve tops, clan t-shirts
- 3 in 1 coat, blazers

If space allows we can accept a limited stock of the following;

- Rugby /Football boots
- Trainers
- Ballet/Tap shoes
- Plimsolls

We often have a few items of cricket kit and judo suits.

We generally have good stocks of all items although popularity does vary and we cannot guarantee to have all sizes available.

PRICING

The uniform shop operates a standardised price list. These prices are set by the uniform shop volunteers based on experience. Individual prices for certain higher value items, such as coats and blazers, may vary according to condition.

Copies of the price list can be viewed or downloaded from the St Piran's website.

Proceeds from the uniform sold can either be fully donated to School Funds or parents can elect to retain 80% and donate 20% to funds. We do not handle cash and parents are charged/reimbursed via their school bill at the end of each term.

As from 1st January 2011 the uniform shop will not be reimbursing parents for items sold for less than £2.

These include:

- Grey shirts
- White shirts
- Ties

We will still stock these for purchase but will be asking parents to donate the proceeds to school funds in order to reduce administration. These proceeds will be spent on the children (such as purchasing additional toys for the play areas).

At the same time the prices of a few items have been increased slightly to better reflect their price from new. These include jumpers and cardigans.

NEW PARENTS

PARENTS LEAVING THE SCHOOL

Parents selling uniform when they are leaving the school should ensure they have left forwarding details. This will enable the bursary to forward a cheque once total proceeds owing have exceeded £10.00 in value.
