Latin trip to Verulamium, St Albans, Friday 19th May 2017

As you will be aware, I plan to take the Year 6 children who are studying Latin to Verulamium, St Albans, on Friday 19th May. Our trip is fast approaching and so here are the final details and arrangements.

Itinerary

Attached is our proposed itinerary.

Transport

We shall leave school at 8.45 am by coach, supplied by Fernhill Travel, and return by approximately 4.00 pm. Children will be expected to attend Chapel as normal. If we get severely held up on our return journey you will be informed by clarion call.

Risk Assessment

A thorough risk assessment has been undertaken. A copy may be viewed in the school office.

Insurance

We have travel and personal insurance for every child on the trip. A copy of the insurance policy may be viewed, upon request, in the school office.

Staffing

The following adults will be present on the trip: Mrs Barlow and Mr Grice.

Meals

You will need to provide a packed lunch for your child. Please ensure all packaging can be thrown away. School will supply extra drinks.

Clothing

Your child will need to wear his/her normal summer uniform, although boys should wear white shirts and ties. All children will need to wear their blazers too. Waterproofs or a sunhat will be required, subject to the weather forecast. If the forecast is for sun please apply sunscreen to your child before bringing him/her to school on the morning of the trip. Please ensure all items of clothing, including waterproofs, are named.

Your child will need to bring a small, named backpack-style bag which may contain a camera, his/her sunhat/waterproofs, lunch etc.

Games, cameras, mobile phones and spending money

The children are welcome to bring cameras, and, again, please ensure these are named. Electronic games and mobile phones may NOT be brought. There will be an opportunity for your child to visit the museum gift shop – £5 - £10 should be more than enough spending money.

Your child will not need any other equipment; pencils, paper etc will be supplied by school.

Medication

Any medication your child may need must be with Matron before the date of the trip. If your child needs to take travel sickness medication, please give this to him/her before leaving home. Please note, however, that our journey time is only around 45 minutes, so hopefully will not give the children enough time to feel travel sick!
