**Year 3 '1940s Britain' outing to Hughenden Manor, High Wycombe
Wednesday 17th May 2017**

On Wednesday 17th May, 3B and 3W will be visiting Hughenden Manor in High Wycombe. Hughenden was used during WWII as a secret base for creating maps used by the RAF in bombing raids over Germany. This wartime era is brought to life in a new exhibition 'below stairs' at Hughenden, where visitors can see what life was like for personnel involved in creating the maps, and how the maps were used by pilots.

Whilst there, the children will take part in four different workshops:

- The war effort – at home
- At home during an air raid
- Hughenden's wartime secret
- The war effort – Dig for Victory

When they come into school on Wednesday the children will change into their PE kit, outdoor trainers and tracksuits. Closer to the time and depending on the weather, we will let them know if they need wellies and a waterproof.
